## **Cirrus Sky Trail Public Open House**

The **City of Laramie Parks and Recreation Department** is holding a **Public Open House** on **Thursday, February 25<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 to 7:30 PM** at **Laramie Fire Station #2, on the corner of Reynolds and 23<sup>rd</sup> Street.**

The Cirrus Sky Trail planning and design team will present the latest developments in the Cirrus Sky Trail project, planned for the Cirrus Sky/ Coughlin Ridge on Laramie's north side. The project will include a public art component.



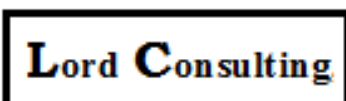
Planning work and public meetings began in 2012-2013 for a bike and pedestrian trail to connect from 15<sup>th</sup> Street to 30<sup>th</sup> Street along the ridge. The Cirrus Sky Trail section is envisioned as part of a future public trail system encircling the entire City of Laramie. New design details include proposed layouts at the 15<sup>th</sup> Street, 22<sup>nd</sup> Street, and 30<sup>th</sup> Street trail connections, and options for public art proposed along the trail.

If you have ideas for the trail, please by all means bring them to the open house! Let the team know your perspective on the proposals being presented. City staff and consultant team members will be available to describe the proposals, answer any questions, and record comments and suggestions from the public.

The planning and environmental clearance phase is nearly complete and this will be the final public open house for the project. Engineering design work will begin in March, and construction will hopefully begin later this summer or fall. Barring unexpected delay, the project should be substantially complete in late 2016 or early 2017.

The Cirrus Sky Trail project is funded in part by a Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant from the US Federal Highway Administration and Wyoming Department of Transportation.
