

**LARAMIE CITY COUNCIL  
RESOLUTION NO. 2019-71**

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING TWO MEMBERS TO THE MONOLITH RANCH ADVISORY  
COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING**

**WHEREAS**, through Resolution 2008-83, the Monolith Ranch Advisory Committee was formed for the preservation of water rights on the Monolith Ranch; sound agricultural practices are necessary to protect and show increased beneficial use of the Dowlin Ditch rights for future transfer of agricultural water rights to municipal rights; drought conditions and water demands are increasing across Wyoming and across the West due to climate change; and the City of Laramie has an unprecedented water supply in the Dowlin Ditch priority water rights on the Laramie River; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 2017-37 specifies appointments serve a three (3) year term ending October 31<sup>st</sup> of the appropriate year; and

**WHEREAS**, Marius Favret was appointed to serve a term expiring October 5, 2019; and Amy Nagler was appointed to serve a term expiring October 10, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, two (2) vacancies will exist for terms of three (3) years expiring October 31, 2022 and City Council shall fill the vacancies pursuant to Section 15.04.040 of the Laramie Municipal Code; and


**WHEREAS**, a two-week advertising period and subsequent interviews have been successfully conducted by City Council Representatives; the following candidates are recommended for approval by the governing body.

**NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING, RESOLVES:**

**SECTION 1.** That City Council reappoints Marius Favret, whose three-year term expires October 31, 2022;

**SECTION 2.** That City Council reappoints Amy Nagler, whose three-year term expires October 31, 2022.
